オランダなぎなた連盟

オランダが初めてなぎなたと接したのは、フランスでの剣道講習会で船原先生と田中先生がなぎなたのワークショップをされた時でした。

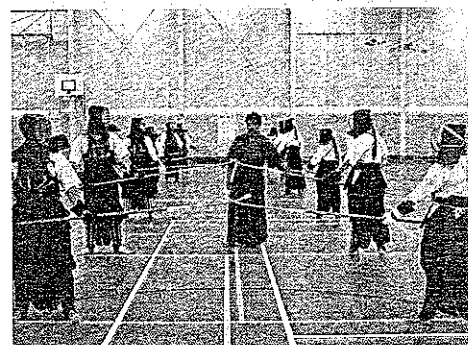
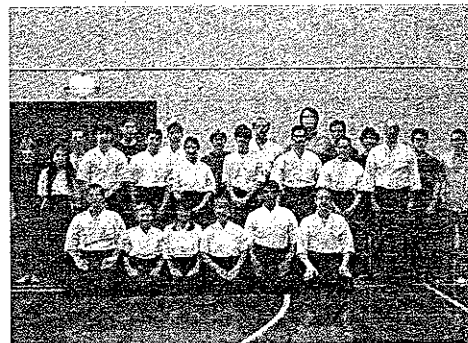
以後1979年までは実際に稽古は行われず、個人で足さばきや面打などをしていました。

1979年日本・オランダの文化交流で武道団がオランダを訪れて、なぎなたとの結びつきを新たにしました。徳永先生、野田先生、その他の先生方が素晴らしいデモンストレーションとワークショップをされ、スネ当てとなぎなたを置いていただきました。

1980年に連盟結成の動きがあり、1986年に現会長ラボーエン氏が今日の連盟を設立しました。

現在5ヶ所で毎週稽古が行われており、ナミ会とサクラ会の2つのクラブがあります。

当連盟は毎年2回週末講習会を主催し、国内を回って公開演武やデモンストレーションを行って普及に努めています。



Nederlandse Naginata Renmei

History:

The Netherlands first came in contact with naginata in 1977, this was when Funahara Sensei and Tanaka Sensei had given a workshop during a kendo seminar in France. Due to the lack of knowledge and the distance between the people who wanted to learn naginata actual practice did not start until 1979. Until that time individuals practiced ashisabaki and men uchi by themselves.

In 1979 there was a cultural exchange between the Netherlands and Japan in which a delegation of Budo Sensei came to the Netherlands to demonstrate kendo, iaido, kyudo and naginata in several cities around the country. This renewed the ties with naginata and there were demos and workshops given by Tokunaga Sensei and Noda Sensei with a large group of interested people. During the second Dutch kendo championships in the Hague the two Sensei gave a fantastic naginata demonstration. At the end of this Budo week the Sensei

gave sune-ate and naginata to the Netherlands so that they could start naginata.

The idea to start a Naginata Federaton for the Netherlands came in 1980 when Andre Raboen discussed this with Suzuki san (kendo, The Hague). During the 80's Andre Raboen went to Japan to learn more about kendo and naginata (naginata in Tokyo and Itami). After 1986 Andre Raboen committed himself to naginata and made the Nederlandse Naginata Renmei into what it is today.

Currently naginata is practiced weekly in five dojo in the cities of Middelburg, Breda, Tilburg, Capalle aan den Ijssel and Utrecht. There are 2 naginata clubs in the Netherlands : Nami-kai and Sakura-kai. The Nederlandse Naginata Renmei (NNR) organizes 2 weekend seminars every year and spreads the name of naginata with regular workshops and demonstrations around the country.
